The Swiss-Group team has just returned from a trip to Gaziantep in the beginning of July, where we were able to assess the situation of our orphans and strengthen our presence on the ground.

Today, the humanitarian situation is particularly fragile. The Turkish government is exerting increasing pressure for the return of orphans and their families to Syria, despite the ongoing instability in the country. Some children have already been forced to return across the border. Fortunately, they remain close, which allows us to continue to provide them with essential support.

As if that were not enough, the halt in U.S. humanitarian aid further complicates the situation on the ground. And yet, despite all these obstacles, we are not discouraged. We remain deeply motivated to continue our mission, thanks to your solidarity and the strength you bring us. Our medical team is present on the ground, and thanks to your donations, we have been able to provide wheelchairs and hearing aids to those in need. We continue to help our orphans on a daily basis, and the good news encourages us: one of our young orphans is now in remission from cancer, a precious victory for him and for all of us!

We were also able to support the Tell Abyad dialysis Centre, which is unique within an 80 km radius, which was threatened with closure. Thanks to your donations, he can continue to welcome its patients every week.
